On Wednesday, January 3, 2024 the East Okotawick Township advisory met to rearrange. Those present were, Roy Miller, Todd Warner, Melissa Miller, Simon Leitz and members Duetna, McElroy, Amy Dixon and Del Rupp. Duetna called the meeting to order and Amy read the minutes. Del made a motion to approve the minutes and Duetna and the motion. They were approved as read. Officers elections were Duetna, McElroy Chairmen, Amy Dixon, secretary; Del Rupp member. The secretary bond was approved for \$600,000 and recommended by the supervisor. Melissa Miller told us pay for part-time temporary help would not be the supervisor's at 18⁰⁰ per hour was the amount recommended by the board of supervisors for the auditors to be the pay set for any supervisor working on the Miller Simon Leitz and all other years supervisors working on the roads were paid "top pay" not 18⁰⁰ per hour. This would be a \$ of 35 pay cut for any

supervisors or working on the roads
Shawn stated she did not think this was
fair. Todd Adams said he did not feel
\$1800 per hr. pay for supervisors was fair.
Ray Hillen stated the pay for supervisors
who work was set in previous years
but no supervisors were paid for any
work in the past 5 years. Ray also
stated any other temporary part-time
person who works on the roads
will be paid \$1800 per hr. Melissa
said part-time help was budgeted
at 1800 per hr. and the supervisor
set the rate at \$1800 per hr. for
temporary part-time help that is
used. Dany Dvorn made a motion
for all supervisors who work
on roads to be paid \$1800 per hr.
Del Bupp disagreed so the motion
was not carried. Del Bupp made
a motion that part-time temporary
help be paid \$1800 per hour and
send out Township supervisors
working on the roads be paid
\$27.36 per hour. Dvorn and
the motion and the motion

was approved. We could not
initial the Township minutes as
they were not yet typed. We
agreed to initial the minutes at
a later session. Todd asked if the
auditors if the supervisors sign
off on bank statements? Any Dvorn
responded that in the past supervisors
did not sign off on bank statements.
Tom questioned signed on checks
and asked if we had a problem
with Tom members of one family
signing checks. The auditors
agreed that we had no problem
with that as long as two signatures.
The auditors discussed and made
changes to the letter sent to
residents on taxes collected.
The changes were required due to
changes in supervisors. Del made
a motion to approve changes on
the letter Dvorn and the motion
and the motion carried. Three
additional audit dates were set,
Dvorn made a motion to adjourn
and Del. and the motion:
